The principals have indicated that this Independence Ride will become an annual event.

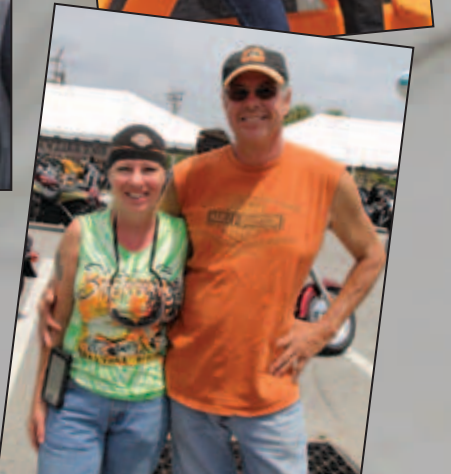


# EARTHQUAKE RALLY 2016

# MEMORIAL DAY 2016

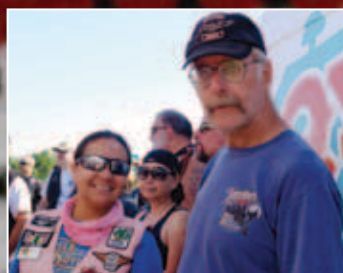

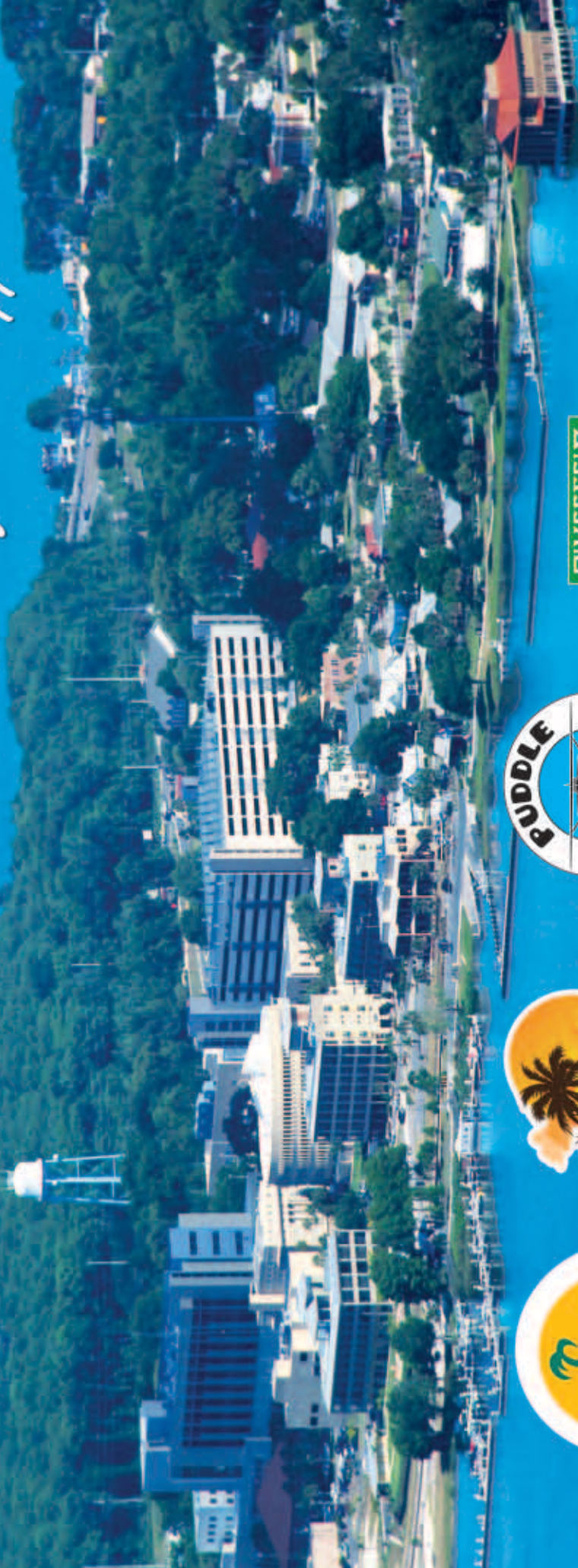
