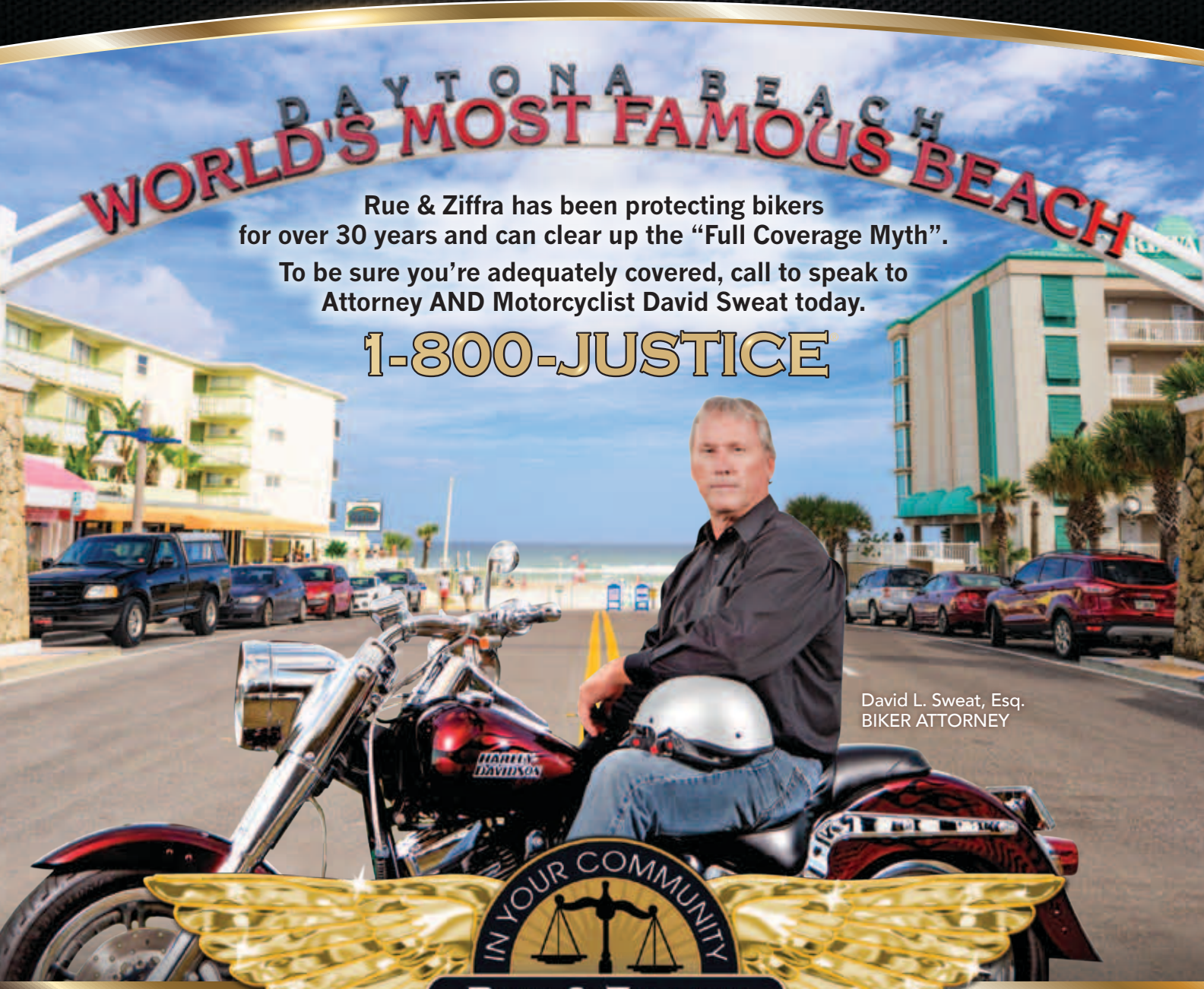
# GATOR HARLEY-DAVIDSON LEATHER & LACE GOLF TOURNAMENT

Hurricane Matthew laid its deadly force on Florida cancelling the 8th Annual Unity Outreach Think Pink Ride for Breast Cancer in October. Cancer of any kind doesn't stop for extreme weather and neither do we, so the ride for Hope, Support, and Research was rescheduled for November 19th. We rode together on heavy steel with loud-ass pipes alongside comfy Cruisers kickin' jams through City & Swamp. A harmony of sorts was thrown together to raise awareness and lofty dreams of ultimately eliminating this cancerous threat.
