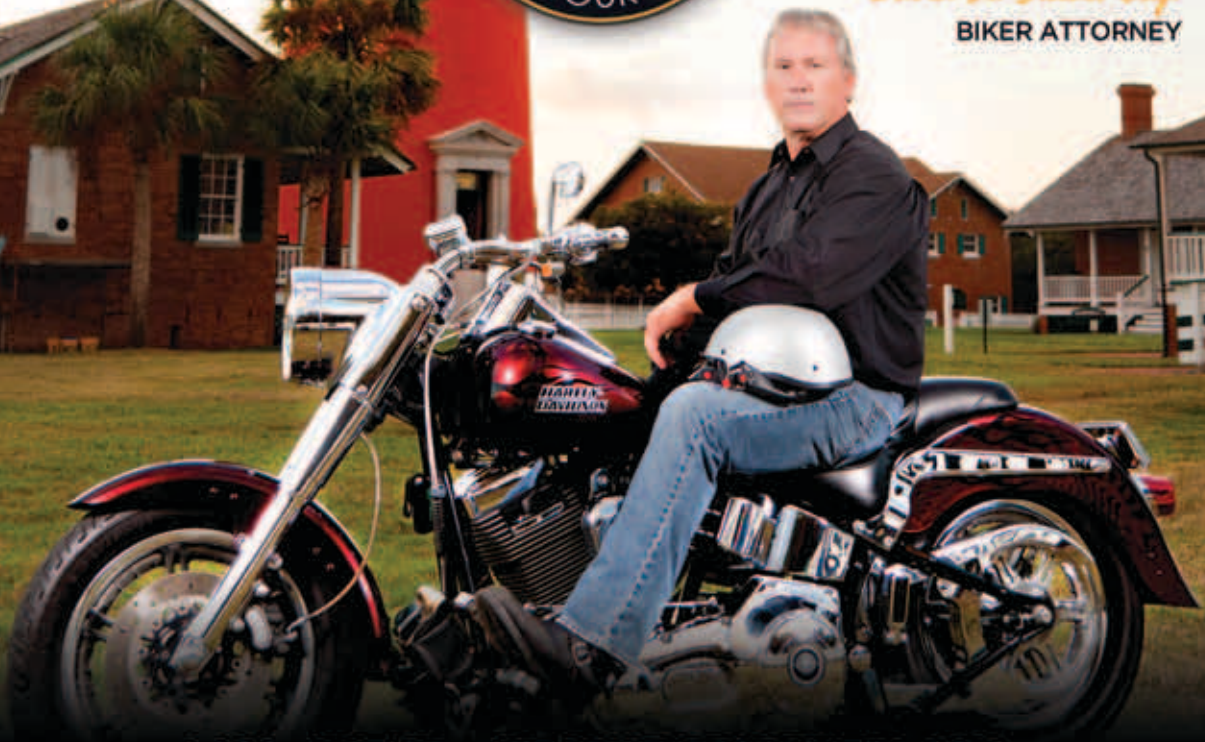

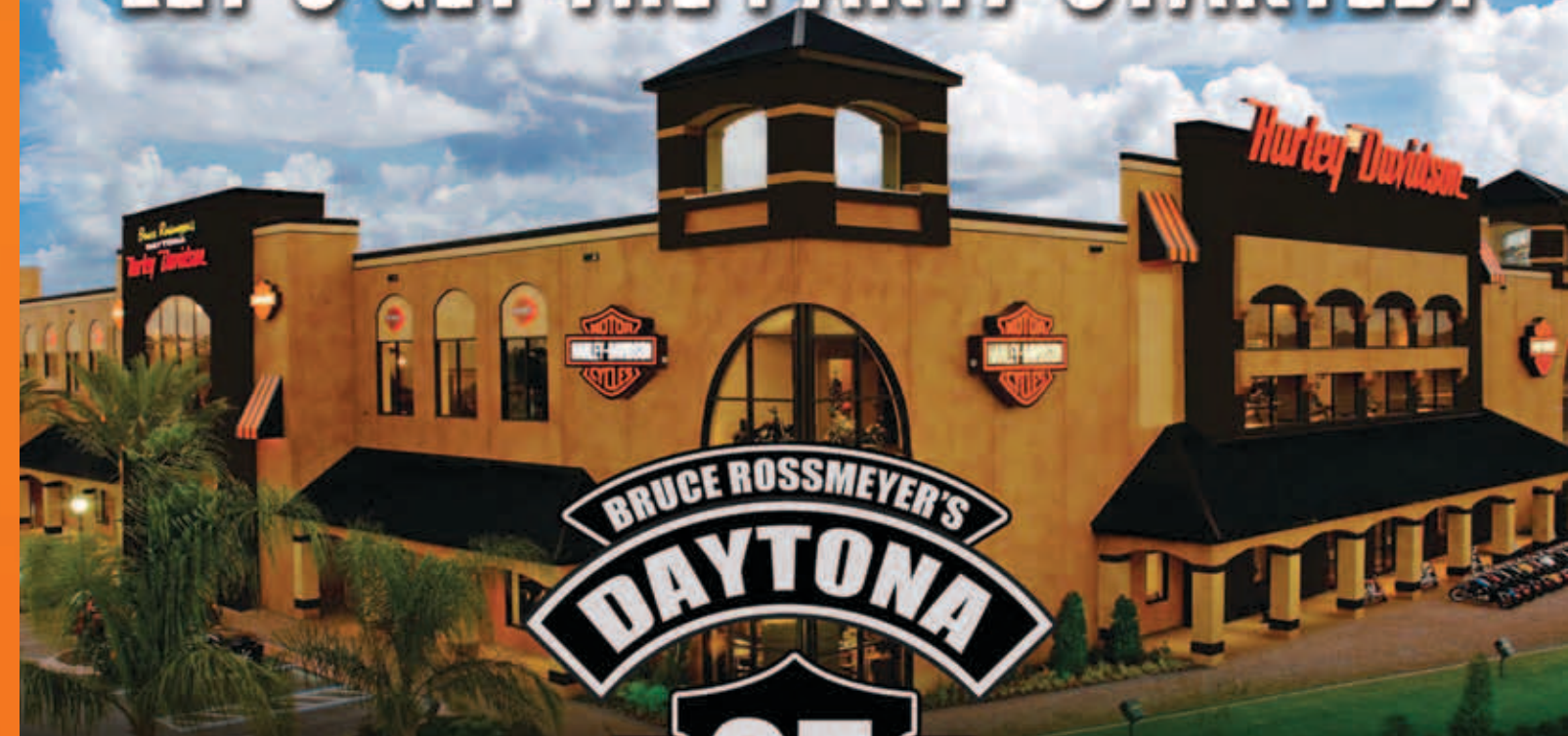

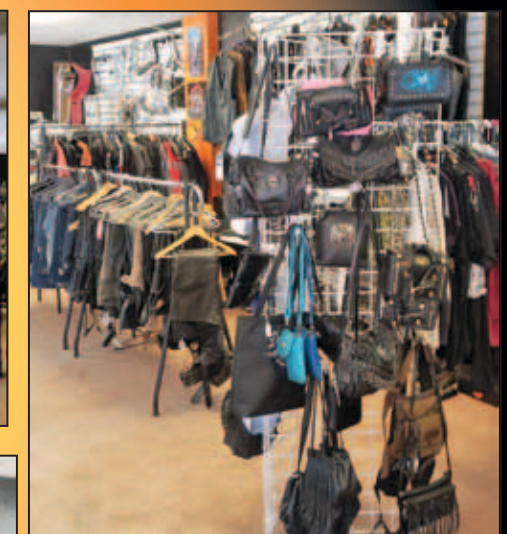
Biking Business:

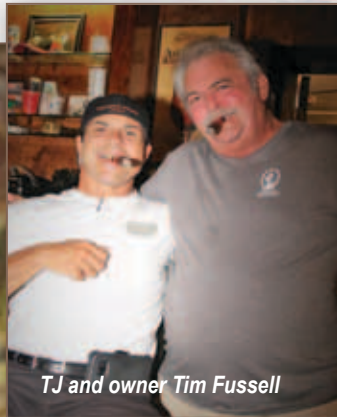
Cool Joint
