



I'm originally from Colorado and was leaving the Spring Rally in Panama City when I was arrested in Pensacola. I was supposed to be in Sturgis to meet some friends of mine from the band Hooligan's Holiday who were scheduled to play at the Lake on August 12th or 14th. I was also supposed to help rebuild the Full Throttle Saloon and show off a couple of custom trikes me and my best friend built in his garage. Due to my incarceration I was not there and will have to reside in Pensacola until my legal issues are resolved. My next court date is August 23rd which explains my reason for not being there. I've been here since May 1st and unsure when I will be released. I would like to ask if you could send me the latest issue of Thunder Roads Magazine Florida so I can keep up with the most recent event happenings in the area and let me know how I can get information concerning the events at Sturgis Bike Rally going on as you're reading this letter. Could you help a brother out with these requests? It will be greatly appreciated. I would also like to help you in your efforts to keep the magazine in full operation. There isn't much I can do while incarcerated but your efforts will be rewarded anyway I can help to contribute upon my release.

Thank you for taking the time to read my letter and considering my request. Until next time hug everyone you know like it is the last hug!!! Ride safe and ride on. My address is at the top of this letter. Thank you!!!

So hopefully you will get this one before you are released. Hope the legal system lets you out soon! So you can live behind bars that are attached to a motorcycle!!!





Orlando H-D'S HOGS FOR HOPE RIDE GREATLY SURPASSES FUNDRAISING GOALS FOR ONEORLANDO FUND

Orlando-Harley Davidson's "Hogs for Hope" ride more than doubled its fundraising goals last week when more than 500 motorcycle riders drove past the Pulse Nightclub to show support for the victims of the June 12 tragedy and raise money for the OneOrlando.org fund.

The ride raised \$45,500 more than double its original \$20,000 goal. Accompanied on Sunday July 24th by Orlando Police, more than 500 riders came together and rode through downtown Orlando, stopping briefly in front of the Pulse Nightclub, the site of the June 12 tragedy that left 49 people dead and more than 50 others wounded.

"I am enormously proud of Orlando Harley-Davidson and our motorcycling community for coming together to help the Pulse attack victims and their families," said Anne Deli, owner of Orlando Harley-Davidson and who organized the ride. "As we rode past Pulse and the Honor Guard we had posted there, it was an incredibly emotional moment. The victims and their families have so many needs due to the injuries or trauma caused by the accident. 












SOLDIER SONGS & VOICES

Soldier Songs and Voices provides musical instruction, instruments and songwriting workshops to help veterans express their feelings and experiences of war. Founder of the Sarasota/Manatee chapter Ray Hodges and singer songwriter Debbie Hood did a fantastic job with the event and Cathy, owner of Mango Jo's was a perfect host. 

I now, more than ever, truly appreciate her philosophy of always taking shortcuts where you can, as long as your ultimate outcome is that of down home, labor of love cooking.

SIMPLE FETTUCINI ALFREDO WITH KIELBASA & SCALLIONS

1 Bottle of Fettuccini Sauce (next to spaghetti sauce at any grocery)

- 1 Box of Fettuccini pasta or Linguini pasta; your preference
- 1 Package of Kielbasa (2 if you want really meaty)
- 1 Bundle of scallions (green onions) large chop including the green part

Put your big pot of water on for pasta; remember to salt well. Cut your kielbasa in 1/2 inch pieces and sauté' in margarine or olive oil, whichever you prefer. Sauté' until you get a good caramelization on all pieces of meat. Remove and drain on paper towels. Take same pan and throw your chopped up scallions in and let them get a little browned. Drain your pasta, dip out a 1/4 cup of the water. Put drained pasta into a big ceramic bowl, add a heaping tablespoon of quality margarine or butter, then add the Fettuccini sauce, salted water and the kielbasa & scallions. *Sautéed mushrooms would be excellent also. Blend it all together; top with real Parmesan cheese and open a good wine. Serve w/ hot, crusty bread. This is so inexpensive to make and it tastes delicioso'.

Next spoon on a quality pizza sauce, tear pieces of basil and lay on one side of bread. Then add 12 pieces of quality pepperoni and then layer with slices of real mozzarella. Put a dollop of butter in skillet, let it melt down, place sandwich in skillet and let sit until moves easily; flip when golden brown and then brown the other side. Let cool a minute and then slice. Heat up extra sauce to dip it in. So easy to make. Kids & kids at heart love this gooey, crunchy samich.
