# SOUTHERN COUNTRY CUSTOMS REVVING UP FOR 2025!

f you have been on the Broken Spoke Saloon property in Ormond Beach during Bike Week or Biketoberfest, you probably stopped in to visit Rusty and Steve Wallace. They have made the Broken Spoke their home away from home, displaying their amazing custom bikes. Rusty Wallace and his son, Steve have taken "tinkering" on their own bikes to an insane level. I wanted to delve into how this came about and what sets them apart from other builders, as in this economy, some builders have struggled to stay afloat, yet Southern Country Customs has sixteen custom bikes commissioned to build and in six short years they have built 1321

Steve who is the master builder, raced cars like his dad for fifteen years, and his home in Mooresville, North Carolina, about twenty-five miles north of Charlottle, is where his "race shop" has morphed into a "motorcycle shop." He said he and his father have been on two wheels as long as he can remember. His dad raced motocross as a kid, Steve laughingly claims "100 years ago" even way before becoming the 1989 Winston Cup Champion. Even when they both were racing cars, they were always tinkering on and accessorizing

es and that is what led

to building bikes. Of course, coming from the NASCAR mentality, speed and high performance is a must for these bikes. Rusty at one time was sponsored by Harley-Davidson and Miller Lite, and he raced to Victory Lane several times. So, the entry into bike building seems like a natural progression. Since launching Southern Country Customs in 2019 quoting Steve, "the bike building has gone ape shit and there is no time for auto racing anymore". He works seven days a week and takes what he does "very, very seriously." His goal is to be "the best at it and to build high performance bagger bikes that are "SHOW and BIG TIME GO!" And this, with knowledge acquired over the years, is what makes Southern Country Customs so successful. Rusty also builds and has been the sole builder of his personal bikes which are all masterpieces. He has remained heavily involved in the day-to-day operations of the business since the launch of the brand.


So, what sets Southern Country Customs apart? These rides are sleek looking pieces of art with incredible paint jobs. Chris Fox & Jason Vanderwoude are his painters of choice. The bikes are built for riding and performance. The bikes can cruise at 100 miles an hour as straight as an arrow. These are hardcore high-performance motorcycles. These bikes are extreme and although they come with an extreme price tag ranging between \$70,000 and \$130,000 the customers line up to buy them. One customer in Maryland has purchased nine of their builds, and another Maryland client has purchased three!!! And here is what I think really makes these bikes sellable...customer service and satisfaction! Satisfaction with the ride! The paint! The service! They even bring a mobile workshop trailer with every spare part to their bikes, including engines and transmissions, to the rallies and never leave a customer hanging! I asked Steve had any reality TV approached him about a show like the old OCC and his response was quick, "Yes and my answer was no, I am not looking for fame or stardom, I'm just focused on building my brand and reputation in the industry."

Steve built forty bikes by himself but as he realized he couldn't keep up with the orders coming in, he added Josh Schoelkopf who can do it all, Alex Rodriguez as a fabricator and Charlie as a mechanic. Lee Gibbs takes care of sales and can be reached at 704-740-0705 for questions or stop in and see them at the Broken Spoke Saloon on US 1 in Ormond Beach February 28th-March 9th from noon to 6:30p daily. They will have sixteen of their creative builds onsite so come out and take a look!

# **Amber's Annual** Poker Run


