# Understanding Comparative Negligence in Florida Motorcycle Accidents



If you're involved in a Florida motorcycle accident, it's crucial to understand how the state's modified comparative negligence law affects your ability to recover compensation. Since 2023, you can only recover damages if you're 50% or less at fault, with any award reduced by your percentage of fault. Determining fault is complex, involving traffic laws, road conditions, and the actions of multiple parties—all of which can significantly impact your case.

## FLORIDA'S MODIFIED COMPARATIVE NEGLIGENCE SYSTEM

Florida's shift to a modified comparative negligence system in 2023 introduced one key change:

(1) You must be 50% or less at fault to recover damages

For instance, if you're found 30% at fault in an accident with \$100,000 in damages, you can recover \$70,000.

#### However, BEING 51% AT FAULT ELIMINATES YOUR RIGHT TO COMPENSATION.

Motorcyclists face unique challenges under this system. Without the same PIP coverage as car drivers, filing a lawsuit is often necessary to recover damages. Helmet use, while not always required, can influence fault percentages and recovery potential. Strong evidence and expert legal assistance are essential for maximizing your compensation.

### **EVIDENCE AND FAULT IN MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENTS**

Establishing fault requires robust evidence, such as:

Scene photos and videos document critical details like vehicle positions and road conditions, while medical records demonstrate injury severity. Witness accounts and accident reconstruction experts can clarify events, and police reports often include valuable information on traffic violations and road conditions.

Multiple parties may share fault from other drivers to government agencies responsible for road maintenance. Each party's actions are scrutinized under Florida's negligence laws. For example, if you're texting while riding and a car runs a red light, you may share fault, which impacts compensation but doesn't disqualify recovery if you're 50% or less responsible

# FILING DEADLINES AND INSURANCE CLAIMS

Timing is crucial in Florida motorcycle accident cases. You have two years from the accident—or from the date of death in wrongful death cases—to file a lawsuit.




# GATOR H-D FALL RALLY 2024


















# **OB's Panhead/Shovelhead** Best in Show 1937 Indian Chief 2024









Other than a great day of riding, drinking and friends that love motorcycling, bike shows are about a chance to spotlight the many hours someone tinkers in a small shed restoring history or creating a piece of rolling art. And in Ron Herman's case, the Best in Show 1937 Indian Chief, was definitely that. Ron is a native of Erie, PA but escaped the cold for better riding weather and now resides in Largo, Florida. In a 12x14 shed in his backyard, he put together a masterpiece out of pieces he searched the world for. The engine and transmission came from Florida, the rolling chassis, wheels, frame and front end from Albany, NY, but other parts were gathered from South Dakota, California, Belgium, Australia, Czech Republic, and swamp meets! Ron informed me that Australia has the largest collection of 741 model Indians. It took 6 months for him to get this bike together. He also had some help. Jim Seidell from West Hampton, Massachusetts did the transmission and engine work. It is the 219th engine Jim has under his belt. The paint was actually done in his shed (the fourth paint job under Ron's belt) with phone assistance from a friend named Pork in Live Oak. The leather work was done by Wayne Hagler of Heather's Leathers in Clover. SC.

Needless to say, Ron spends hours tinkering in that shed. I asked if his wife is supportive and it almost sounds like she sends him there instead of "the doghouse." He says he has been together with Diane for 14 years, married for twelve, and that she totally supports his past time. His first motorcycle ride at 14 years old was his mother's 305 Honda that he would "steal" out of her garage. His first legal bike was at 19 and was a 650 Yamaha. His stable presently includes a 2016 Indian Vintage and a new "shed project" a 1941 Chief that he is working to turn it into a bobber! Sounds like this 63-year-old biker still has the love of Indians and I can't wait to see his next creation. Thank you, Ron, for bringing this bike to OB's and congrats on your win!
