




27th Annual Thunder by the Bay Music & Motorcycle Festival 2025

A LOCAL GEM

Every town has its charms. LA has its stars, and New York City has its overpriced bagels. Dallas has cowboys

- We have Willie Perry. I had the honor of sitting down for an interview with Willie, getting an inside look on his love for motorcycles, the history of Tropical Tattoo, his contribution to the community, and his loyalty to Rue & Ziffra. Plus, an exclusive look into Willie's Top 5 BBQ Restaurants in Florida!

GENERATION OF TATTOOS

Located in Ormond Beach, Willie's Tropical Tattoo opened in 1991, when there were only three to four tattoo shops in the area. It was one of the most recognized studios in all the Southeast part of the United States and carried its popularity into the early 2000s. "You tattoo people in the 90s, later on tattooing their kids," Willie says. "We thrived to keep a great reputation for over 35 years."

A great part of keeping that reputation came from building relationships with those in the community. It's important to involve your neighbors. Which is why Willie started his annual "Chopper Time" bike show. During Bike Week and Biktoberfest, bikers from across the map ride to Willie's Tropical tattoo and park their bikes, old and new, alongside one another. Locals and tourists come together for a day of appreciating custom artwork and old-school craftsmanship, with live music, food, giveaways, and booths hosted by local business owners. Riding since he was fifteen, Willie had always been surrounded by other bikers, and a diverse group of beautifully crafted bikes. "I have tons of friends in the biker community," he says. Not only did the heavy influence of motorcycles drive him to several places around the country (from the Carolinas to the Dakotas). but it also brought him a family. "A lot of bikers would come to the shop and ride around- Fancy bikes- We decided to have a bike show here." And apparently, it wasn't planned to be the huge event that it is today, but boy are we glad that it is!

Chopper Time is the place to be if you're a biker, or a motorcycle enthusiast, but that's not all it is. The annual event was created to raise money for the Veteran Support Fund, which aids local disabled Veterans, and has been gaining the attention of other organizations who all have the same goal in mind: To uplift one another. Along the way, proceeds have also gone to animal shelters and nursing homes.

Helping the community was never a new concept to Willie. He is a regular volunteer at the Emory L. Bennett Memorial Veterans Nursing Home of Davtona Beach.

"They really want to interact with people," Willie says, referring to the patients who know him well from over the years. And he has made connections with the heroes at ARNI (a foster rescue organization that relies on foster homes to care for animals waiting for their forever homes)

THE F IN FIRM STANDS FOR FAMILY

Willie is so big on community, and chooses the sponsors for his events so wisely, that naturally I was curious as to when his loyalty to "Rue & Ziffra" began. "Super nice people, some of the nicest people I've ever met. They took care of me," he says, referring to the RZ team. He then goes on to tell me the story of the day that changed his life.

Four years ago, Willie was in a motorcycle accident that kept him in the hospital for two months. "It was devastating," he says. "They helped because they care -Always there to answer questions. Really big help for my wife, too." Since then, he's been a loyal supporter of Rue & Ziffra.

> "You wanna know the difference between them and other firms? They treat people like family."

In this day and age, where tattoo shops are on every corner of every city's main street, it's important to stand out. "It's changed now- it's advanced so much," says Willie. "Almost every shop has at least one really great tattoo artist." It's not enough to do what is expected, but to do that and so much more; to think outside of the box. Which is exactly what Tropical Tattoo does. Because like Rue & Ziffra, community and building relationships comes first.

Curious about the connections he's made over the years, I asked "And those who have gotten to know you -What's something they would all know about Willie Perry?" Of course, riding his bike was on the list, but following close behind was an interesting hobby: "Everyone wants to go to bars on their birthday," Willie states. "Not me - I'd rather have really good barbecue."

WILLIE'S RULE TO A GOOD BBQ.

Willie's first ever BBQ trip (that he can remember) was to Fat Boys in Fort Pierce, years ago, which lead me to ask: "What makes a good BBQ?" As if recited from his own book of BBQ Do's and Don'ts, Willie responds: "The smell of the smoke, the meats gotta be well done. Some people like it a little fattier. That's okay too. I sometimes just smell the smoke and follow it. And the sauce- You



really don't need a lot of sauce on good BBQ. Shouldn't need it." And I picture him taking these rules with him all the way to his next stop: Yet another Red Hot and Blue Memphis BBQ, but this time in North Carolina. Willie says he's always on the lookout for a new BBQ place to pop up!

WILLIE'S TOP 5 FLORIDA BBQ

When I called to schedule an interview with Willie, he had been on his way back from getting BBQ in St Augustine. "I actually went to two BBQ places this week, that's funny."

WOODPECKERS BACKYARD BBQ. ST. AUGUSTINE

BBQ meats by the plate or the pound! A down-home setting with outdoor seating -Known for the brisket and countless sauce options - Though Willie's very strong on his opinion of what makes a good BBQ, and apparently the sauce shouldn't influence the final decision making: "You don't need to put a lot of sauce on good BBQ."

MISSION BBQ, CLERMONT

"Nice lean brisket," Willie points out. "Lots of flavor." And upon further research, friendly staff and good service is also a staple at Mission BBQ! "They also do a lot for the Vets." The website, easily accessible, has a Veterans VIP Club sign up.



FUEL BBQ, SANFORD

"Mission and fuel are pretty close together," Willie says pensively. Marketed as the "Old school low and slow BBQ," Fuel supposedly offers the "reaL deal" pulled pork, ribs, and chicken. And of course, the brisket. You can never forget about the brisket. Willie will make sure you never do.



BB RAD'S COASTAL BBQ, TITUSVILLE

Smoked meats, slaw and fresh cornbread- What else can a BBQ enthusiast like Willie ask for?



RED HOT AND BLUE MEMPHIS BBQ, ANYWHERE AND EVERYWHERE

"One of my favorites - it's a chain," Willie says. "It's popular for its pulled pork and ribs." Known as "Genuine American BBQ." RH&BM is a Blues-themed BBQ restaurant with a Memphis-style menu. It's located in several places, all of which Willie has visited: Boca, Lake Mary, Daytona just to name the Florida ones (although the Daytona location has unfortunately closed down) "Yeah, Ronald Reagan brought it to DC, actually - That's how it got started," Willie states (how it got started) - North Carolina, Virginia -"I think I've been to every single one that's ever been."






